Mayor Luke Price opened the meeting with the pledge of allegiance and invocation.

He then began by reporting he had attended a meeting in Ft Wright with Becker Engineering firm regarding fire hydrants. He felt it was a very productive meeting and will be moving forward with the project.

He had also met with the Falmouth Housing Authority Board and felt confident of the direction being taken. fall under the jurisdiction of the County. Judge Fields wanted to look at what the City currently uses and change as needed.

Keene Dougherty was on vacation, but they were reviewing damages from the hail storm, and fencing was going up around the lot for safety concerns.

Marty Hart reported that Kyle Florer had been hired, Matthew was not out of the academy. He was working with Enterprise on 5 vehciles with hail damage.
