INTRODUCTION AND GENERAL INFORMATION

The City of Falmouth is requesting bids for pavement resurfacing and pavement milling on various roads and streets in the City of Falmouth.

SCOPE OF PROJECT

The City of Falmouth is seeking a Contractor to provide all labor, material, supervision, equipment, construction staking, and incidentals required for street paving in the City of Falmouth. The project will span several streets in the City of Falmouth (see spec section)

CONDITIONS:

All envelopes containing a bid proposal must have the following information on the outside of envelope clearly marked: "SEALED BID ROAD PAVING AND MILLING PROJECT"

Bids can be dropped off during normal business hours at City Hall located at 230 Main Street Falmouth, KY 41040.

The City of Falmouth will receive sealed bids until: 5:00 PM MONDAY 2th, JUNE 2025.

Sealed bids will be opened Thursday June 5th at the regular scheduled

Meeting @ 7:00 PM 230 Main St Falmouth, KY 41040 in the Council Chambers.

BIDDERS QUALIFICATIONS:

Contractor must demonstrate to the satisfaction of the City of Falmouth that he or she has adequate equipment, personnel, experience and understanding of the specifications to perform the services requested.

Each bidder shall thoroughly familiarize himself/herself with all conditions and locations of the streets as well as the specifications within this bid document before preparing their proposal.

INSURANCE:

Awarded Contractor will be required to provide proof of liability and workers' compensation insurance before work can begin on the project.

INSPECTION:

All work performed will be subject to inspection by the City of Falmouth. The Contractor shall notify City Hall 72 hours prior to any placement of asphalt. The Contractor shall take care not to damage any of the areas outside the limits of this project. If the Contractor's operation causes damage to the street, sidewalks, curb and gutters, ADA sidewalk ramps, or other structures outside the areas of this project, the Contractor shall replace such damaged items at no cost to the city.

BUSINESS LICENSE:

Successful bidder must comply with the City of Falmouth Occupational License Fee Ordinance. Vendors must obtain an occupational license from City Hall prior to start of project.

SPECIFICATIONS:

A short synopsis of the required work to be made on each street is requested, in addition to pricing. The list of streets should be itemized by street name and a description of necessary repairs/work. A grand total of the project should be listed at the end of your itemized list.
